Dr. Terry L. Jones, age 64, of Huntington, WV, received peace by entering Heaven on Tuesday, April 2, 2013. He is survived by his wife Suzanne G. Jones, and family: Derek T. Jones (Nashville, TN), Chase, Alana, Slade and Miles Jones (Missoula, MT) and Allison and Andrew Brewer (Huntington, WV). He is also survived by four brothers and their spouses and children from his birthplace of Philippi, WV. He also enjoyed golf, the West Virginia Mountaineers, travel and reading. His spirit of service touched many, and he will be remembered for many things...especially never meeting a stranger and a legacy of loving well and making people smile.
